Visitors to the school should be directed to the School Director. The school reserves the right to inspect lockers for maintenance, security inspections, emergencies and enforcement of our Drug/Alcohol Abuse Policy, or for other reasonable causes.

The purpose and authority of school personnel are limited to securing the premises and protecting the facility. The enforcement authority of campus security is limited to the enforcement of school rules and regulations. Incidents that go beyond the scope of security personnel are referred and investigated by the County Police Department.

To ensure accurate and prompt reporting of all crimes, school personnel will take a written statement from all involved parties and witnesses at all reported incidents. The written statements are included as part of the written report. Such statements are used by the school and/or local/state law enforcement authorities for criminal apprehension and/or crime prevention.

The school is in compliance with the Drug Free Schools and Communities Amendment Act of 1989.
